<u>Danish History</u>

Peter T. Scherrebech: He is regarded by many sources as the first Danish settler in California. He came to Yerba Buena in 1835. The town, at that time Mexican, later became San Francisco. In 1844 he became the first police officer in the town. Later he was a tax collector and elected to the town council. He was elected with 86 votes while the candidate, J. Cooper, only got 2 votes in 1847.

He was born 18 Aug 1813 in Skærbæk, Hoptrup, Haderslev. Christened "Peter Skerrebek". Son of farmer Thomas Simonsen and wife Bodild Kirsten Scherrebeck. As with many of this era looking up history on him is somewhat confusing. In some places his Danish name is used Skerrebek, at other it is Scherrebech and even his decedents use Schubert as the spelling of their last name.

He Married a Mary Sullivan (or maybe Stevenson) and their firstborn, a daughter, was the second "White" Child of Anglo-Saxon Race, born in Yerba Buena. The little girl was born in 1846 and was named Cathrine.

Mary's Brother was one of the founders of Hibernia Bank in San Francisco.

Peter was first of all known as a carpenter and master builder. He constructed many buildings in the region of San Francisco and built his first home on the corner of Kearny and Washington streets, later the El Dorado and the, Parker Hotel. Peter T. Scherrebech was of the opinion that he built on his own grounds that belonged to him. He claimed that Governor Castro gave him a larger area of land as part of a land grant, between Market Street and Rincon Hill and between 2nd and 3rd Streets there were about 12 City Blocks. After California became a State and Scherrebechs submitted his claims, they were registered on 3 March 1853, but they were rejected as invalid by the Country Commission on 6 March 1855. Some years Later, on 3 December 1859, this was overturned by the United States district Court. This order aroused great commotion in the young city, a study was started and some months after the Court's ruling, there was evidence to show that the Scherrebechs claims were invalid. The case ended in the United States Supreme Court which ruled that his claims were invalid in 1891.

Scherrebech has certainly believed that he was in his rights, but the papers were not submitted in time. (Scherrebechs son's widow, said that it was Scherrebechs Brother-in-law, lawyer Frank Sullivan, to whom Scherrebech had entrusted the supervision of his Grant, had neglected to have his map Approved in time).

The land Scherrebech claimed in 1853 was worth a fabulous fortune. It now covers well over 500 building plots in a densely populated business and residential district.

Only one year after the final decision of 1860, Peter T. Scherrebech passed away.

His Son Thomas J. Scherrebech was born November 21, 1851 and after his Mother passed away in 1879 moved to San Jose, where he lived near the Alum Rock Road and McLaughlin Avenue in the east San Jose.
