# A brief History on Carl Plow.

Carl Plow was elected Grand President in 1899 during the Convention held in Petaluma. Carl was a Charter Member of Sønderjylland #10, and their first Secretary in 1893. He was Born on December 24, 1863 in Denmark, near Haderaley, The son of a school teacher. Coming to the United States on July 4th, 1880 and worked on his Uncle's Dairy in Petaluma. Over his long professional career where most of it was spent as the Manager of a local Creamery, The California Central Creameries. It was during this time that he was elected Grand Secretary in 1906, the only Grand Officer to be elected that year due to the earth quake. He holds the record for the longest serving Grand Secretary with over 27 years, From 1906 until his death in 1934.

As I wrote in an earlier article about the history of Aldersley, in San Rafael, PGP Carl Plow was the first Manager and Secretary of the New Home until 1925. Aldersley is located at 326 Mission Street and the Plow Family home was at 335 Mission Street San Rafael. Carl although very active with Dania from 1893 until his death on November 14, 1934 he also was an active member of other fraternal Organization. Petaluma Lodge No, 30, I.O.O.F., Relief Encampment No. 29, I.O.O.F., Canton Petaluma No. 10, Morning Star Chapter No. 61 Order of the Eastern Star, Petaluma Rebekah Lodge, and of Petaluma Lodge No. 180 Free and Accepted Masons. He was also a social Member of the Danish Brotherhood

and Dannebrog. He served on local School boards the last being in San Rafael.

In 1922 His Majesty, the King of Danmark, bestowed upon him the title of "Sir Knight of Dannebrog" the decoration of that ancient order of nobility being for services rendered his native land.

In late 1933 Carl authored the Book "Dania 1879 – 1933" commonly referred to as the "Plow Book". According to a Newspaper article written in the "Petaluma Argus-Courier" of December 3, 1933 Carl Plow was asked to write a story in pamphlet form of the activities of the first 53 years of Dania to be placed in the Danish-American Library at "Sohnnegaardsholm" in Aalborg Denmark, but as he pointed out in the article he found that there was such a vast amount of topics to cover that the intended pamphlet became quite a lengthy Book. The Grand Lodge paid for the printing of two thousand copies of the 200page Book. The printing was done by "Bien" who was in San Francisco at the time and did all of the Grand Lodges' publications. I still have two unsold copies in the inventory of the Grand Secretary. Several past history articles printed in this newsletter were taken from his book.

Over the years there were many well attended dinners held in his honor by both the Grand Lodge and by Sønderjylland #10. It is easy to see that PGP Carl Plow was a will respected and loved individual of our Danish Community, Petaluma and his home land.
