1893 -Ferndale Danish Hall October 10, 1929 - Ferndale Enterprise NEW DANISH HALL DEDICATED YESTERDAY BY LOCAL LODGES

Building - Credit to the Community.
The new Danish Hall of the Ydun (Dannebrog) and Fjeldronning (Danish Sisterhood Society) local lodges was dedicated last evening. Personal invitations sent out to the various Danish Lodges of the county and to individuals who contributed to the hall brought together an exceedingly large crowd for the excellent

Circa 1929 Blum Warehouse before remodeled During the evening two comical plays were given which kept those in attendance in a peal of laughter from beginning to end. Vocal solos also added to the program, which was so cleverly arranged by JE Petersen, Mrs. Jeppe Jespersen, Mrs. J Thomsen and Mrs. P Jacobsen, Jr.

After the program a sumptuous banquet was given under the management of Mrs. John Christiansen, Mrs. Andrew Meng, Mrs. Fred Petersen and Mrs. JJ Hansen. It was at the elaborate supper that a number of interesting addressees were made by local lodge members and by visitors who complimented the owners of the hall upon their splendid building which is indeed a credit to the community.

Later in the evening cards were enjoyed and those who cared to dance gathered in the social hall. The music for the dance was donated for the occasion by Leven C Ericcsen.

All the efforts of those who have worked so long for the new Danish Hall have certainly been worth while as it is most complete in every detail.

More History of the Danish Hall, Ferndale CA

The property was purchased from Henry C Blum on May 7, 1929 and dedicated on October 10, 1929. The original purchase price of \$2000.00 for the property included two lots. The cost to remodel the building into a Lodge Hall cost \$7663.33.

The second lot was later sold off to Dr. Denning in the seventies. Fjelddronning Lodge Danish Sisterhood Society and Ydun Lodge Dannebrog sold half of their interest to the other two Danish Lodges; Gimle Lodge Danish Brotherhood Society and Valhalla Lodge Dania on June 20, 1977. Each lodge owning 1/4 undivided interests in the Hall until 2003. Valhalla Lodge Dania bought out Danish Sisterhood Society and Danish Brotherhood Society's interest acquiring 3/4 interests in the Danish Hall with Ydun Lodge Dannebrog retaining their 1/4 interest on November 12, 2003.
