However, the spread of the virus seems to have slowed to 1:1, down from 1:1.2 a month ago. That is a very technical interpretation of how Covid-19 is spread, but an important issue in Denmark. They also had a serious issue with the

virus spreading into the mink farms in Denmark, mutating and re-infecting humans. That caused a total lockdown in North Jylland, with restriction on travel to and from the region. A very scary situation and a threat to whether the new vaccines being developed would be in-effective for the mink mutation. Fortunately, it seems the lockdown has been effective and the mutated virus has died out in Denmark.

Here at home we are all staying safe as we hope all of you are too. Wearing masks, (John had a small supply of N-95 masks from a couple of years ago, US manufactured 3M brand) and now the entire Cruger-Hansen family has their own N-95 masks. A great relief when we must go out for shopping and the like. President Debbie is still teaching her 4th Grade students remotely via ZOOM, and is discovering a whole new set of programs and skills that benefit her teaching methods and her students.
