In 1995 they were both honored along with 30 others by Queen Margrethe II and the Danish government in Copenhagen. Festivities included a reception at City Hall, a memorial service at Holmens Kirke, dinner and entertainment onboard the Queen's yacht, and a special play at the Royal Theater. To top it all, the Seamen's Union organized to gather them all to be seated together by the Memorial Anchor in Nyhavn, Copenhagen where Queen

Margrethe II showed up and was seated opposite. Each name was called up and the Queen would look at each exactly one minute as a thank you for their bravery during the war. Very touching and memorable."

Dania and Dannebrog have a rich past and bright future. I have closed the past few articles with the quote "We're getting the band back together!", but I think we are back together now. It is already May and the summer will be here before we know it. Keep checking the calendar for activities everybody! Don't let an opportunity to gather and have fun pass you by.
