On Tuesday July 19, 2023 I Had the privilege to attend the official groundbreaking at Aldersly Retirement Community, representing Dannebrog and Dania. The groundbreaking was for their Marselisborg expansion project. The project has been in the planning stages since 2015, 100 years after the Aldersly community was first conceptualized by members of Dania and Dannebrog. The Aldersly board, neighbors and community spent a lot of time developing the concept and site plan along with an artist conception on what the project would look like. The final step was securing the 75 million dollars to finance this great project.

Shannon Brown, Executive Director Aldersly, welcomed all of those in attendance. She then introduced Peter Schakow, president Aldersly Board of Directors and a member of Danmark #2 of Dania. Peter provided a brief history of the founding of Aldersly by the members of Dania and Dannebrog and how the home has evolved to what it is today. He then went into the process of developing the concept of Marselisborg to where they are today.

Maribeth Bushey, Councilmember in San Rafael, spoke a few words and indicated how excited the city and neighbors are with the project. Soo In, Principal Perks Eastman, and Nick Misakian, Project Manager with Cahill construction, provided some words on their company's involvement with the project.

After the brief remarks there were ceremonial pictures of various groups shoveling dirt for the official groundbreaking. It has been many years since I last visited Aldersly. Before the festivities I had a chance to walk the grounds. They have done a lot of projects to keep up with current trends and changes in the retirement community as well as improving services to the residents. I enjoyed my time there and reacquainted myself with the Aldersly community facility. If you are ever in the area, drop by and visit Aldersly. I am sure they would love to show you around!
