More than a hundred years have passed since twelve Danish ladies lodges in California became the Danish Ladies Society Dannebrog, auxiliary lodges of Grand Lodge Dania, the name the result of the legendary appearance of the Dannebrog more than 800 years ago. Recognition, also, of the special ladies of Ydun, Ferndale's Dannebrog lodge instituted on the 9th of November 1912. A notable Danish business person, one of 13 children, Ole Kirk Kristiansen (April 7, 1891 to March 11, 1958) was a talented carpenter in Billund, Denmark who founded a construction toy company in 1932, later known as The Lego Group. He then transformed his small woodworking shop into a manufacturer of wooden toys in 1934 and officially named the company, *Lego*, and established its fundamental principles. After the acquisition of a plastic injection molding machine in 1947, his business shifted to producing plastic bricks – Legos.

Karen Haugse, in the absence of President, Kristin Worthley, called the meeting to order at 12:08 p.m. and welcomed 14 members. There were no visitors, guests, or new members. We sang God Bless America. We celebrated two October birthdays: Judith Thompson (absent) and Darlene (present) and sang Happy Birthday. Darlene received a free birthday lunch from the Lodge.
